DETAILS OF WORK

On September 19, 1951, at 6:17 P.M., 5 1/2" casing was landed at 1870 feet with 75 sacks of cement. Rotary tools were moved off and cable tools moved on to drill cement plug and pay. On September 24, 1951, bailed hole dry and remained dry for two hours. Drilled forty-seven feet of solid cement in bottom of pipe and again bailed dry. Hole remained dry for two hours which was considered a satisfactory water shut-off test.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
