This form shall be submitted to the nearest Office of the Oil Conservation Commission, and from which oil or gas is produced. It shall be filed for each transporter authorized to move oil or gas. If the certificate has been approved by the Commission, one copy shall be forwarded to the transporter and the other two copies retained by the Commission.

A new certificate shall be filed for each change in ownership and each change in the transporter's name. If a temporary change in the transporter is made, within the allowable production for one operation period, the transporter, upon filing a new certificate, notify the Oil Conservation Commission, by letter of the estimated amount of oil or gas to be moved by the transporter temporarily moving oil or gas from the field. A copy of such temporary transporter and a copy of such letter shall be retained by the transporter. Such temporary transporter shall not move oil or gas more than the estimated amount of oil or gas.

This certificate when approved by the Commission, shall be retained by the transporter and shall remain in full force and effect.

- (a) Operator's name and address
- (b) Transporter's name and address
- (c) The permit to move oil or gas

If any of the above information has not been furnished, the transporter shall be held fully under the provisions of the Act.

In all cases, when the transporter is not the owner of the oil or gas, the ownership or ownership shall be shown under the transporter's name, and the transporter previously indicated in the certificate.

A separate report shall be filed with the Commission by the Oil Conservation Commission.
