DETAILS OF WORK

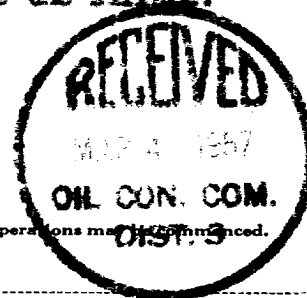

It is intended to drill & dual complete a well in the Pictured Cliffs formation & Mesa Verde formation. Mud circulation will be used thru the Pictured Cliffs formation & set intermediate casing. Gas circulation will be used thru the Mesa Verde & a production liner will be set. Possible productive intervals will be perforated & fractured. Estimated Total Depth 4750'.

Casing Program

10 3/4" at 160' with 125 sacks cement circulated to the surface.
7 5/8" at 2490' with 250 sacks cement.
5 1/2" liner at 4750' with 300 sacks cement.

The W/2 of Section 24 is dedicated to the Mesa Verde.
The SW/4 of Section 24 is dedicated to the Pictured Cliffs.
W/2 Section 24 - BM 04206.
