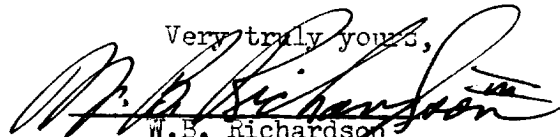

As you will remember, while Glenn and I were in Farmington we discussed with C. Beeson Neal the State Deliverability Test on the Turner-Kutz Deep Test Number 1, located in the SE/4 of Section 22, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, San Juan County, New Mexico.

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Following my return to Dallas, I talked with Mr. W. B. Nacey, of the Oil Conservation Commission in Santa Fe, and he instructed me to the effect that if we would move forward with all dispatch toward securing such a State Deliverability Test this well would be given a tentative allowable as of March 1, 1955 and we would not be penalized.

As you are undoubtedly aware, this well was sold to El Paso Natural Gas Company as of December 1, 1954. However, Glenn retained a production payment payable out of, among other wells, this well, and, therefore, it is to Glenn's interest to have an allowable assigned to the same even though he is no longer operator of the well.

Therefore, if you will kindly talk to officials of El Paso in Farmington and secure their permission to have this well tested by San Juan Testing Service at their very earliest convenience we will greatly appreciate the courtesy. Please

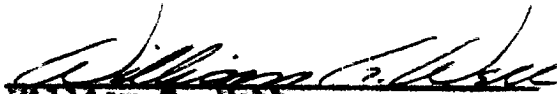
