This request is on behalf of the above-referred-to operator.

It is requested that the above-referred-to wells be waived from the requirement of having a lined pit for produced water due to:

- 1. The wells do not produce water in sufficient quantity to require a separator.
- The wells are occasionally blown into the atmosphere to remove small quantities of water.
- 3. The water, when blown to the atmosphere, occurs as a mist and cannot be collected and quality and quantity determined.
