4 1/2" at 7058' with two stage tool 100' below base of Point Lookout & third stage 100' below base of Pictured Cliffs.

1st Stage - 300 sacks - 150% to cover 100' above top of Gallup.

2nd Stage - 300 sacks - 150% to cover 100' above top of Cliff House.

3rd Stage - 160 sacks - 150% to circulate.

The E/2 of Section 22 is dedicated to this well.

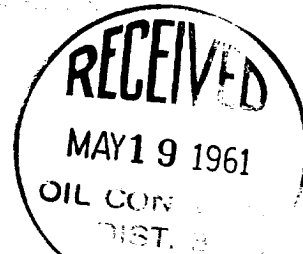

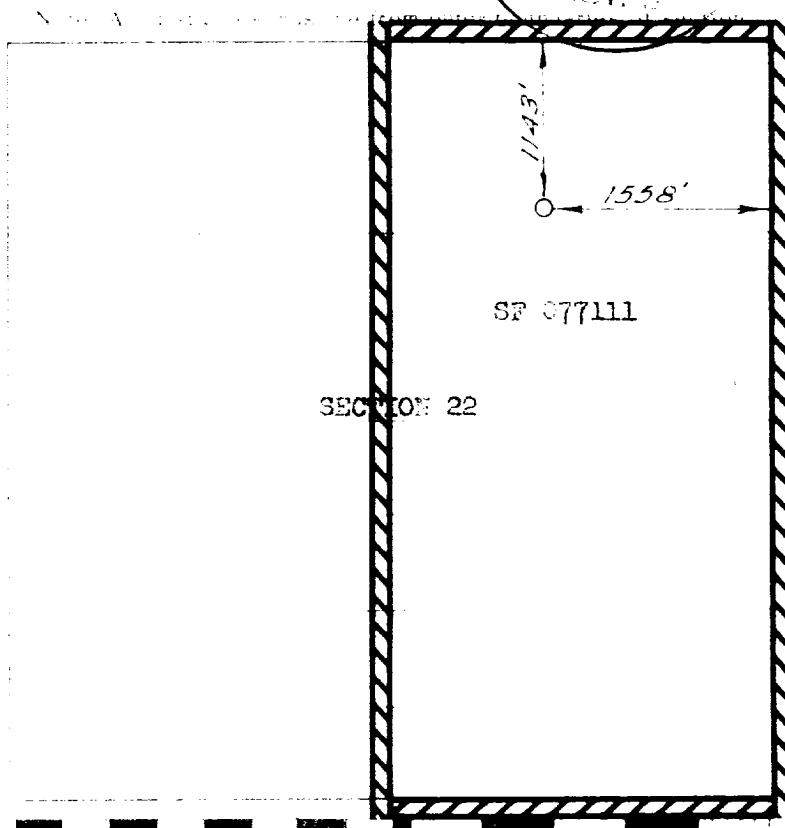
