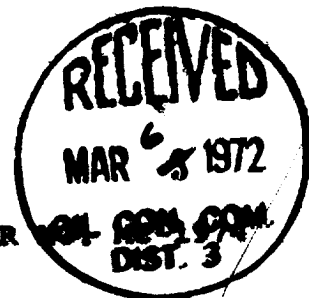


THE APPLICATION OF AZTEC OIL
& GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER



**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 4, 1972, for permission to dually complete its Reid Well No. 20 located in Unit A of Section 19, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 24th day of February, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Reid Well No. 20 located in Unit A of Section 19, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.

THE APPLICATION OF ASKED FOR
A GAS COMPANY FOR A CULM COMMISSION

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Oil & Gas Commission made application to the New Mexico Oil Commission on February 4, 1971, for permission to drill a well in the Rio Grande No. 20 located in Unit A of Section 19, Township 36 North, Range 3 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool and the Rio Grande Pool.

Now, on this 14th day of February, 1971, the Commission, by its order, directs:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 113-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations.
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of oil and gas wells have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause undue non-competitive rights.
- (5) That the retention of the proposed dual completion and its associated and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, being the San Juan County, be and the same is hereby authorized to drill and complete its Rio Grande No. 20 located in Unit A of Section 19, Township 36 North, Range 3 West, NMPN, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesa Verde Pool and the Rio Grande Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 113-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall not operate the well until after completion and analysis of the well.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That production of this well as hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
