DETAILS OF WORK

The objective sand is the Pictured Cliffs. The top is expected at about 1950 feet. The producing string will be 5 1/2" O.D. casing which will be cemented.
Approximate casing program:

100' of 8-3/8" O.D. cemented
1950' of 5 1/2" O.D. cemented with approximately 100 sacks.

Well will be drilled with rotary to top of Pictured Cliffs sand, 5 1/2" O.D. casing set, and will be drilled into pay zone with cable tools.

Well will then be shot with approximately 150 quarts of Nitro Glycerine.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.

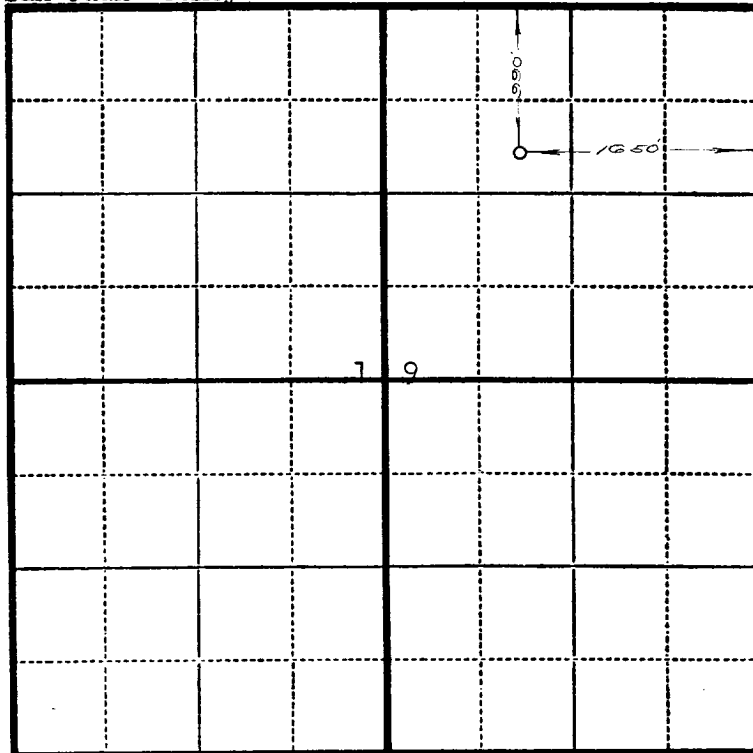
