DETAILS OF WORK

We Propose To:

1. Set 10 sx. cement plug over perforations in 4 1/2" liner from 1970 ft to 1850 ft.
2. Cut off 5 1/2" Csg. at lowest free point. Spot cement plug from 50 ft. inside 5 1/2" stub to 50 ft. above 5 1/2" stub using approx. 35 sx. regular cement.
3. Fill open hole with drilling mud to surface pipe.
4. Spot 10 sx cement plug in top of surface pipe. Erect regulation marker and permanently abandon well.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
