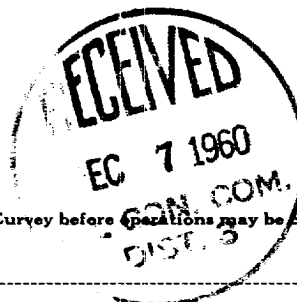

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Spun well November 11, 1960 w/ cable tools.
2. Ran 8 joints, 9-5/8", 32,346, 4-10, surface pipe on Nov. 13, 1960. Cemented w/ 250 sz. regular cement w/ 2% calcium chloride. Flow down 5:30 P.M. Nov. 15, 1960. Cement circulated to surface.
3. rd. up rotary rig on Nov. 20, 1960. Pressured up on surface pipe to 800 psi. for 30 minutes. Pressure held.
