THE APPLICATION OF ARTEC OIL & GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.

ORDER NO. MC-1956

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION CONSISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Astec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on October 20, 1971, for permission to dually complete its Reid Well No. 19 located in Unit B of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, MAPM, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

How, on this 27th day of October, 1971, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Reid Well Ho. 19 located in Unit B of Section 18, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, BMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED ECHEVER. That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHIR CADERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
