Form C-128 submitted with Redfern & Herd's #1 Phillips well in Unit C, Section 16-28N-11W shows an acreage dedication of 160 acres. Commission Order R-1287 signed November 21, 1958 establishes 320 - acre dedications for Dakota gas wells in the San Juan Basin. Will you please re-submit this plat indicating which half-section you wish to dedicate.

On future Dakota wildcats 320-acre dedications should be shown. The wells may be located in either quarter of the half-section and must be a minimum of 790 feet from the quarter-section line and no nearer than 130 feet to the quarter-quarter-section lines.

wells may be located in either quarter of the half-section and must
be a minimum of 250 feet from the quarter-section line and no nearer
than 150 feet to the quarter-quarter-section lines.
