

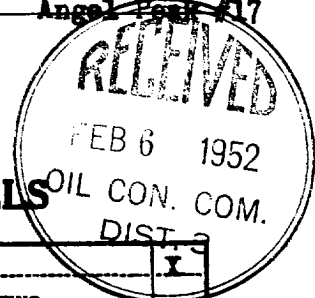

DETAILS OF WORK

Well was spudded January 22, 1952, 148 ft. of 8-5/8" with 75 sx. at 153 ft. Casing tested for 30 minutes with 500# pressure with no leaks. Plug was drilled January 24, 1952, tested for 30 minutes with 500# pressure with no drops in pressure.
