


THE APPLICATION OF AZTEC OIL
& GAS COMPANY FOR A DUAL COMPLETION.



ORDER NO. MC-1980

**ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION**

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Aztec Oil & Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 23, 1972, for permission to dually complete its McClanahan Well No. 18 located in Unit A of Section 13, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 25th day of February, 1972, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Commissions Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That a waiver of objection has been received from the offset operator and the waiting period as prescribed by said rule may be dispensed with in this instance.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED: That the applicant herein, Aztec Oil & Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its McClanahan Well No. 18 located in Unit A of Section 13, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to produce gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the Basin-Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Commission may deem necessary.
