Set 2050' of 5 1/2" casing through Pictured Cliffs. Perforate Pictured Cliffs with four shots per foot. Sand-water frac with approximately 10,000 gallons water and 10,000 lbs. sand. The production unit of 1/3 acres, M 1/1, is assigned.

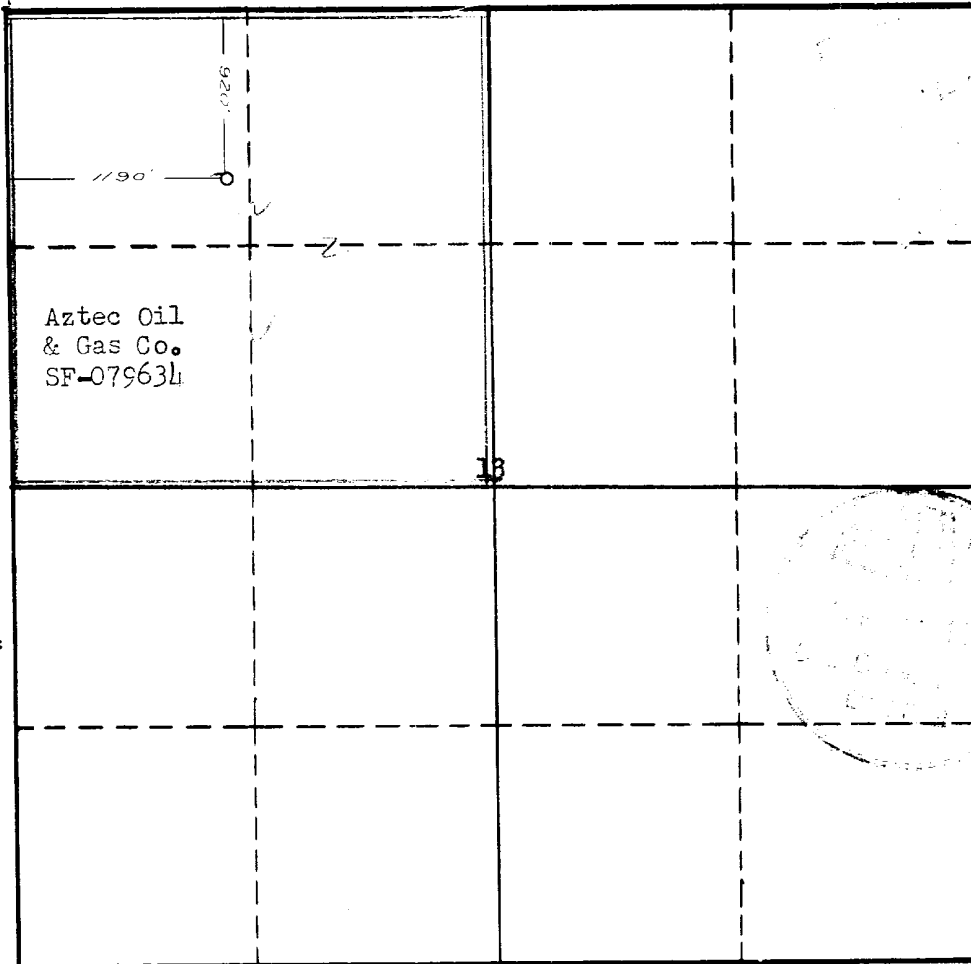
