

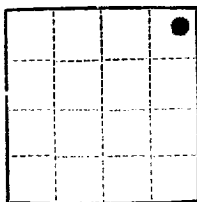

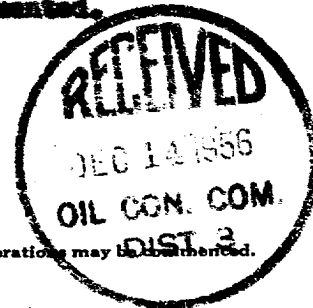
DETAILS OF WORK

Approx. 100' of 3" surface casing will be circulated with cement.

The Farmington sandstone will be cored at 650 and if favorable oil and showing are found a string of 4 1/2" casing will be cemented.
