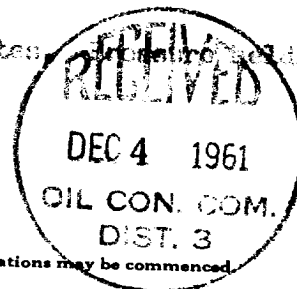
Well No. 19/ is located 700 ft. from S line and 1450 ft. from W line of sec. 12

DETAILS OF WORK

1. Rig up rotary tools. Spud 12 1/2" surface hole 9:30 A.M. 11/22/61.
2. Drilled to T.I. of 263'. Ran 3 joints 2-5/8" OB. 24.00', J-55 surface casing. Landed at 261' B.K.B. Cemented with 150 sacks regular cement w/2% calcium chloride.
3. Cement circulated. Plug down 3:30 A.M. 11/23/61.
4. Pressured up on surface casing to 1000 psi. for 30 minutes. 11:00 A.M. 11/23/61.
5. Drilling ahead with 7-7/8" hole.
