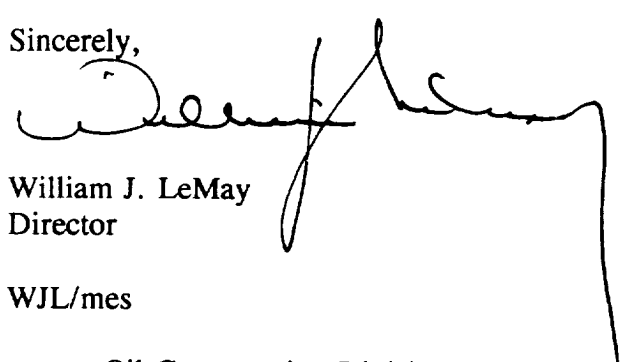
Dear Mr. Hawkins:

Reference is made to your application dated July 22, 1994 for a non-standard Basin-Fruitland coal gas well location for your existing Schwerdtfeger "A" Well No. 1 (API No. 30-045-11615) which was drilled in 1965 and completed in the Basin-Dakota Pool at a standard gas well location 1050 feet from the North line and 1510 feet from the West line (Unit C) of Section 36, Township 28 North, Range 9 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the Dakota interval will be properly plugged back and said well will be recompleted to the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, which pursuant to the Special Rules and Regulations for the Basin-Fruitland Coal (Gas) Pool, as promulgated by Division Order No. R-8768, as amended, is unorthodox. Further, lots 1 and 2, the NW/4, and the N/2 SW/4 (W/2 equivalent) of said Section 36 shall be dedicated to the well to form a standard 318.85-acre gas spacing and proration unit for said pool.

By the authority granted me under the provisions of Rule 8 of said Order No. R-8768, as amended, the above-described unorthodox coal gas well location is hereby approved.
