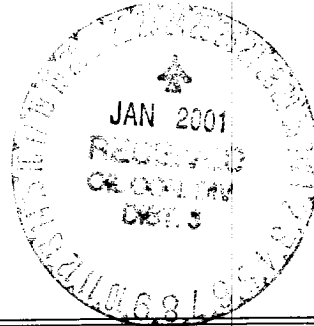

In response to the Notice of Noncompliance, effective 01/01/98 Conoco Inc. assumed operations of the above mentioned well from Amoco Production. Amoco initially applied for the DHC and received BLM approval on March 8, 1995 (please see attached). Amoco performed DHC on 9/18/95 but was unable to reestablish production due to liquid loading. Conoco performed remedial work in March 1998 and the MV started producing. Based on production history and swab test Conoco would like to submit the following allocation formula.

- 77% Dakota (Gas & Oil)
- 23% Mesaverde (Gas & Oil)

The Farmington District Office (FDO) of the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) has received your letter dated December 22, 1994, for downhole commingling of the Blanco Mesa Verde and Basin Dakota Pools for the above referenced well.

This well is located on a Federal lease and does require approval of the BLM for commingling. You stated in the application that historical data will be used to determine the allocation percentage for each formation. A review of this well does support the use of historical production data to determine future allocation. Approval to downhole commingle is granted, however we do request that once determined, that the allocation factor be submitted for this well.
