Ran 61 jts. 4 1/2" csg 9.5#. Set at 1990'. Cemented with 190 sacks of Halliburton light cement and 75 sacks of Class "C" Neat. Cement circulated. Pressure tested to 2000#. Held ok. Perforated with 3 1/8" Dense Jets from 1924 - 1934' and from 1916 to 1920', from 1906 to 1910' and from 1874 to 1884', 2 shots per foot.

Fraced with 30,000# of 10-20 sand, and 30,000 gallons of water. Breakdown 2700#. Maximum 2700#. Average 2300#. Displacement 2300#. Injection rate 36 bbls. per minute. Shut in instant 500#. 5 min. 0#. Ran 56 jts. of 1 1/2" Regular J-55 tbg. Landed at 1875.45, 12' KB. Blowing well to clean.
