ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A Tenneco Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 7, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Omler A Well No. 5-E located in Unit E of Section 25, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra formation and the Basin Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 18th day of May, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- 2. That satisactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly noified;
- 3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- 4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- 5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Tenneco Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Omler A Well No. 5-E located in Unit E of Section 25, Township 28 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Chacra Formation and the Basin Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
