ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF THE OIL CONSERVATION DIVISION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A, Flag Redfern Oil Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on April 22, 1981, for permission to dually complete its Aloha Well No. 2 located in Unit D of Section 16, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation adjacent to the Pinon Fruitland Pool and from the Pictured Cliffs formation adjacent to the Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool.

Now, on this 21st day of May, 1981, the Division Director finds:

- 1. That application has been filed under the provisions of Rule 112-A of the Division's Rules and Regulations;
- 2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified;
- 3. That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule;
- 4. That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights; and
- 5. That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Flag Redfern Oil Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its Aloha Well No. 2 located in Unit D of Section 16, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation adjacent to the Pinon Fruitland Pool and from the Picture Cliffs formation adjacent to the Fulcher Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool through the casing-tubing annulus and the tubing respectively.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon compeltion and annually thereafter.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is her retained for the entry of such further orders as the Division may deem necessary.
