The Angel Peak B #24E has been commingled downhole as per administrative Order No. DHC-602. We recommend production allocation as follows:

Gas: 52% Gallup
48% Dakota

Oil: 60% Gallup
40% Dakota

This allocation is based on actual production from both zones during January, February and March of 1986; 1938 MCF and 36 BO from the Gallup and 1754 MCF and 24 BO from the Dakota.
