

I am writing to confirm our phone conversation this morning during which I requested that the Oil Conservation Division dismiss our application for the captioned non-standard spacing and proration unit. Dugan Production has reached an agreement with Meridian Oil wherein Dugan Production's interest in the Knauff #1 is being purchased by Meridian Oil and it is my understanding that Meridian intends to establish a standard 320 acre spacing unit for the Knauff #1 Basin Fruitland gas pool completion.

Please take the necessary steps to dismiss this case from the August 23, 1989 docket and consider this matter resolved with respect to Dugan Production Corp.
