

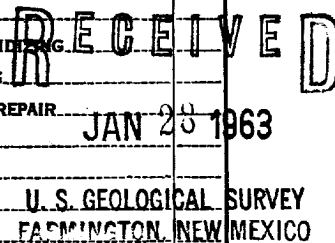

DETAILS OF WORK

TD 1725'. Fished for jars and swedge 10/31/62 - 1/17/63.

Casing: 16" at 66' set with 30 sacks; 13 3/8" at 188' set with 30 sacks; 10 3/4" protection string set at 1725', no cement.

Water sand 40 - 50'; Gas sand 564 - 572'.

To pull 10 3/4" casing, load hole with heavy mud to 580', set 25' cement plug 555' - 580', load hole with heavy mud to 25', set cement plug 0 - 25' and erect dry hole marker of 4" pipe.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
