As requested by the Jicarilla Apache Tribe, Jicarilla (H9) Well No. 1 has been plugged in such a manner that the tribe can convert it to a water well. The road and location have been left for the tribe's use.

Plugged and Abandoned Subject Well as Follows:

MIRU pulling unit on 8-21-87. Bled casing pressure to zero/1/2 hr. R.U. lubricator and retrieved back pressure valve in 2-7/8" tubing. Bled tubing pressure to zero/10 mins. N.U. BOP. Loaded hole with fresh water and well dead. TOOH with 2-7/8" tubing. P.U. 10-3/4" cement retainer on wireline and set at 3300'. TIH with stinger on 2-7/8" tubing and stung into retainer. Established injection rate of 5 bpm at 1500 psi. Squeezed Fruitland perforations 3612-3628' with 175 sacks of cement, mixed at 15.6#/gal., yield 1.18 cu. ft./sx, at 5 bpm at 1500-850-1600 psi. P.O. of retainer and spotted 10 sacks of cement.

Wildcat
Rio Arriba County, New Mexico
9-11-87
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from 3300-3280'. P.U. and circulated hole with 9.2#/gal. mud. P.OOH, laying down 2-7/8" tubing and stinger. P.U. 10-3/4" cast-iron bridge plug and set at 1050'. N.D. BOP and wellhead, leaving 13-3/8" x 11", 5000# starting head on well. Placed cap over 10-3/4" casing. Cleaned up and contoured the reserve pit. Spread topsoil over the location and reserve pit and reseeded. Well plugged and abandoned on 8-21-87.

Note

Jicarilla (H9) Well No. 1 was turned over to the Jicarilla Apache Tribe on 8-21-87 to be converted to a water well.
