

SUBJECT: SALT WATER DISPOSAL WELL

THE APPLICATION OF CONTINENTAL OIL
COMPANY FOR A SALT WATER DISPOSAL
WELL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) Continental Oil Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 14, 1968, for permission to complete for salt water disposal its Table Mesa Well No. 28 located in Unit N of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 17 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico.

The Secretary-Director finds:

1. That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 701 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been provided that all offset operators, surface owners, and the New Mexico State Engineer Office have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Rule 701 (C) will be met.
4. That no objections have been received within the waiting period prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, is hereby authorized to complete its Table Mesa Well No. 28 located in Unit N of Section 33, Township 28 North, Range 17 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the injection of salt water for disposal purposes into the Organ Rock formation at approximately 4904 feet to approximately 5182 feet through 2 7/8-inch tubing with a packer set at approximately 4850 feet in the 9 5/8 inch casing in said well.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. That applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 704 and 1120 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Title 101 (C) Continental Oil Company, made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on November 17, 1938, for permission to remove for sale water from the Tropic Mesa Well No. 22 located in Unit 4 of Section 13, Township 18 North, Range 11 West, T18N, R11W, T4S, County, New Mexico.

The Commission has considered the application.

1. That the application has been duly filed under the provisions of Title 101 (C) of the Commission Rules and Regulations;
2. That satisfactory information has been furnished that all water operations, surface operations, and the New Mexico State Engineer have been duly notified; and
3. That the applicant has presented satisfactory evidence that all requirements prescribed in Title 101 (C) will be met.
4. That no objections have been received within the period of time prescribed by said rules.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Continental Oil Company, is hereby authorized to complete the Tropic Mesa Well No. 22 located in Unit 4 of Section 13, Township 18 North, Range 11 West, T18N, R11W, T4S, County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the separation of salt water for disposal purposes into the Organ Rock formation at approximately 100 feet to approximately 150 feet through 2 1/2-inch casing with a packer set at approximately 150 feet in the 2 1/2 inch casing in said well.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby assumed by the Commission for such further order or orders as may be necessary or convenient for the preservation of waste and/or protection of oil and gas rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after notice and hearing, the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted in the interest of conservation. Such applicant shall submit monthly reports of the disposal operation in accordance with Rules 104 and 105 of the Commission Rules and Regulations.
