Spudded 11-13-61 with rotary tools. Drilled to 1110'. Run 1 1/2" log. Run 46 joints of 5 1/2" ID, 1-55 casing, landed at 1110'. Cemented with 300 sacks of regular cement with good return to surface. Moved, rotary out and cable tools in, drilled to 1121'. Sand lined with 10,000' sand and 7,500 gallons of crude. Grapped clean. Run tubing and submersible pump. I.P. - 68 BOPD and 1680 RWD, gas 151M. Completed as pumping well from 1110'. (Japan-Notes) 1110-1121
