## DETAILS OF WORK

As a result of Gallegos Canyon Unit No. 60 ceasing to produce a measurable volume of gas well was plugged and abandoned as follows on August 25, 1960:

1. Previously open hole 1799-1958' squeezed with 150 sacks of cement.
2. Set 10 sacks cement plug 1751-1799.
3. Filled hole with fluid.
4. Set 100 sacks cement plug 37-525 to cover casing splits at 89-94 and 279-308 and squeezed with 300 psi.
5. Removed wellhead and surface equipment.
6. Spotted 5 sacks cement for surface plug (0-40') and erected dry hole marker.
7. Plug and abandonment operations by above procedure to permit possible re-entry in the event other zones are discovered to be productive in the area.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
