Krause-Federal Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 6th day of January, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (l) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Subsection 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Western Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its G. H. Krause-Federal Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range Il West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.
