ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Western Natural Gas Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on December 17, 1959, for permission to dually complete its G. H. Krause-Federal Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool.

Now, on this 6th day of January, 1960, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Western Natural Gas Company, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its G. H. Krause-Federal Well No. 1 located in the SW/4 SW/4 of Section 32, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of oil from an undesignated Gallup Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota Pool through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests

1 located in the SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 33 North, Range 11 West,  
New Mexico, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the  
production of oil from an undesignated Gallegu Pool and the production of gas  
from an undesignated Gallegu Pool.

That on this 29 day of January, 1958, the Secretary, Director Under

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule

(2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators  
of offset acreage have been duly notified and

(3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period  
as prescribed by said rule.

(5) That the compliance of the proposed dual completion are feasible  
and consistent with good conservation practices.

IT IS THE ORDER OF THE COMMISSION:

That the applicant herein, Western Natural Gas Company, be and the  
same is hereby authorized to drill and complete its C. I. Kraus-Reynolds Well  
No. 1 located in the SW 1/4 of Section 32, Township 33 North, Range 11  
West, New Mexico, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit  
the production of oil from an undesignated Gallegu Pool and the production of gas  
from an undesignated Gallegu Pool through parallel completions of tubing.

GRANTED UNDER ORDER NO. 1 That application shall be complete, operate,  
and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 11-A.

FOR THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION That applicant shall take proper leakage tests

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upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual Deliverability Test Period for the Dakota Zone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
