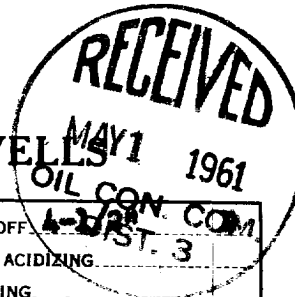

DETAILS OF WORK

Total depth 6580' - Ran Electric log. Set 4-1/2" casing at 6578' with DV tool set at 2102'. Cemented first stage with 275 sacks 6 percent gel cement with 1-1/2 pounds medium tuf plug per sack, followed by 100 sacks neat cement. Tested 4-1/2" casing with 2600 psi which held with no indication of pressure drop. Cemented second stage with 150 sacks 6 percent gel cement. Tested casing with 3000 psi, which held with no indication of pressure drop.

I understand that this plan of work must receive approval in writing by the Geological Survey before operations may be commenced.
