ORDER NO. DC-343

THE APPLICATION OF R & G DRILLING COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SCHLOSSER WELL NO. 25, LOCATED IN THE NW/4 SE/4 OF SECTION 27, TOWNSHIP 28 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, NMPM, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN AN UNDESIGNATED FRUITLAND GAS POOL, AND THE WEST KUTZ-PICTURED CLIFFS GAS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) R & G Drilling Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 6, 1957 for permission to dually complete its Schlosser Well No. 25, located 1850 feet from the South line and 1850 feet from the East line and in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, in an undesignated Fruitland Gas Pool and the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool.

The Secretary-Director Finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, herein, R & G Drilling Company be and it hereby is authorized to dually complete its Schlosser Well No. 25, located in the NW/4 SE/4 of Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such manner as to permit production of gas from the Fruitland formation by proper perforation of the casing with gas produced through the casing-tubing annulus from an undesignated Fruitland Gas Pool and the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation by proper perforation of the casing with gas produced through the tubing from the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool and with the installation of a suitable packer and with the installation of suitable surface equipment to maintain complete separation of the two zones of production.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That subject well shall be completed and thereafter produced in such a manner that there will be no commingling within the well-bore, either within or outside the casing of gas, oil and gas, or oil produced from either or both of the separate strata,

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That prior to the actual dual completion the operator shall make pressure tests of the casing to prove that no casing leaks have developed since the well was originally completed. In the event a casing leak is apparent the operator shall take appropriate steps to adequately repair the leak. The results of these tests shall be reported to the Commission on Form C-103.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well applicant shall submit to the appropriate District Office of the Commission, copies of Oil Conservation Commission Form C-104, Form C-110 and Form C-122 outlining the information required on those forms by existing Rules and Regulations and two copies of the electric log of the well.

THE APPLICATION OF R & C DRILLING COMPANY FOR PERMISSION TO EFFECT DUAL COMPLETION OF ITS SCHILOESSER WELL NO. 55, LOCATED IN THE NW 1/4 SECTION 55, TOWNSHIP 38 NORTH, RANGE II WEST, NMW, SAN JUAN COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN AN UNDESIGNATED FERTILAND GAS POOL, AND THE WEST KUTS-PICTURED CITIES GAS POOL.

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 115-A (c) R & C Drilling Company made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on March 5, 1953 for permission to drill completion of Section Well No. 55, located 1820 feet from the South line and 1820 feet from the East line and in the NW 1/4 of Section 55, Township 38 North, Range II West, NMW, in an undesignated Ellington Gas Pool and the West Kuts-Pictured Cities Gas Pool.

Type Secretary-Director Find:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Rule 115-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations; section 'c' of Rule 115-A
- (2) That administrative information has been provided that all orders of office secretary have been duly fulfilled; and
- (3) That no objection has been received within the mailing period as to the application for dual completion by the Commission's secretaries.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

Type the applicant, Peter, R & C Drilling Company has filed its proposal to drill completion of Section Well No. 55, located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 of Section 55, Township 38 North, Range II West, NMW, San Juan County, New Mexico, in such manner as to limit production of gas from the limiting formation by proper completion of the casing with gas produced through the casing-tubing annulus from the limiting formation by Gas Pool and the producing Cities Gas Pool and with the intention of better production from the tubing from the West Kuts-Pictured Cities Gas Pool and with the intention of a suitable separator and with the intent of minimizing completion separation of the two zones of production.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That subject well shall be completed and operated to produce in such a manner that it will be no commingling with the well-pole, either within or outside the casing of gas, oil and brine produced from either of both of the reservoirs.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That prior to the start dual completion the operator shall make reasonable fees to the casing of bore that on casing less than developed since the well was originally completed. In the event a casing less than the operator shall take the appropriate steps to separate least the less. The leases of these wells shall be tendered to the Commission on Form C-103.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That upon the start dual completion of each subject well applicant shall supply to the operators Office of the Commission, copies of Oil Conservation Commission Form C-104, Form C-110 and Form C-115 original for intimation tendered on those forms by executive Rules and Regulations and two copies of the new.

PROVIDED FURTHER, That said subject well for dual completion and production shall be equipped in such a way that reservoir pressures may be determined separately for each of the two specified strata, and further, be equipped with all necessary connections required to permit recording meters to be installed and used, at any time, as may be required by the Commission or its representatives, in order that natural gas, oil, or oil and gas from each separate stratum may be accurately measured and the gas-liquid ratios thereof determined, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That the operator-applicant shall make any and all tests, including segregation tests, packer leakage tests on completion and during the annual deliverability test of the West-Kutz Pictured Cliffs Pool, but not excluding other tests and/or determinations at any convenient time and in such manner as deemed necessary by the Commission; the original and all subsequent tests shall be witnessed by representatives of the Commission and by representatives of offset operators, if any there be, at their election, and the results of each test properly attested to by the applicant herein and all witnesses, and shall be filed with the Commission within fifteen (15) days after completion of such test, and submit a packer setting affidavit within fifteen (15) days of completion, after remedial work or whenever the packer is disturbed, and

PROVIDED FURTHER, That upon the actual dual completion of such subject well, applicant shall submit to the Commission a diagrammatic sketch of the mechanical installation which was actually used to complete and produce the seal between the strata, and a special report of production, gas-liquid ratios and reservoir pressure determination of each producing zone or stratum immediately following completion.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED, That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
