Dear Mr. Arnold:

TEXACO Inc. desires approval to conduct a ten day test on its Gov't. "E" No. 1, Section 15, T28N, R13W, San Juan County, New Mexico. This well is completed in the Basin Dakota Field and is connected to the El Paso Natural Gas Company system. During the test period gas will be flared.

The purpose of the test is to determine the effects of reduced back pressure on the productivity of the well. During June, 1966, this well produced 3,835 MCF of gas and 1,157 barrels of liquid hydrocarbons, against a line pressure of 500 psi. It is desired to evaluate the economics of permanently installing a compressor or putting the well into a lower pressure system.

It is planned to run this test during late July or early August. If testing of this nature is approved, please sign and return one copy of this letter.

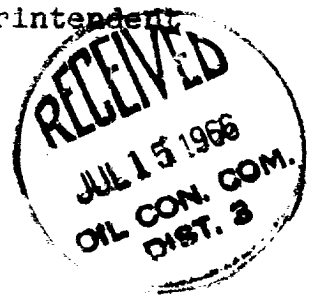
