DETAILS OF WORK

Spudded 12-1/4" hole July 18, 1961. Set 8-5/8" casing at 213' with 175 sacks of cement containing 2 percent Calcium Chloride. Circulated 25 sacks cement. Waited on cement 12 hours, tested 8-5/8" casing with 900 psi for 15 minutes, which held with no indication of pressure drop. Reduced hole to 7-7/8" at 213'. Resumed drilling operations.
