This is with reference to your letter of April 25, 1978, wherein you request an injection pressure increase from 665 to 900 pounds per square inch on your Gallegos Canyon Unit No. 259, injection into which was authorized by Administrative Order No. SWD-195.

Since the instantaneous shutdown pressure on acid treatment was 1000 pounds per square inch and since this is a reflection of the formation fracture pressure, you are authorized to increase the injection pressure to 900 pounds per square inch.
