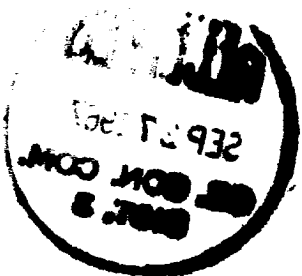

Gentlemen:

We are preparing to drill a Dakota test well on acreage in sections 9 and 10 of T28N-R13W; which has previously been grouped under Order R-1814, this comprises lot 1 and SE $\frac{1}{4}$ of section 9 and all of section 10, totaling 344.42 acres.

Our desired location was 790' from North and East lines of section 10, however because of the extremely rough topography the only feasible location appears to be 900' from the North line and 675' from the East line of section 10, which we hereby request approval of.

We are advising Mr Roy L. Cook, the operator of a Dakota well in section 11 of this request by Registered Mail.

If there is other action we can take to expedite this matter please advise. Enclosed is a surveyor's plat showing the canyons and proposed location.

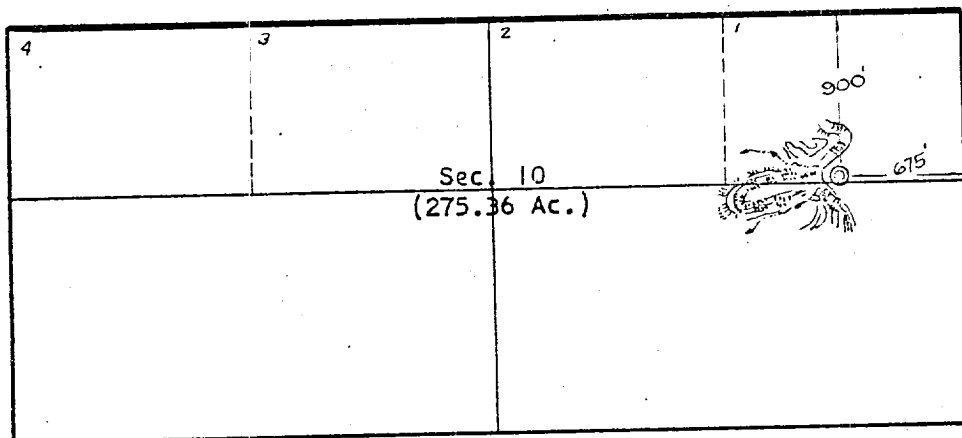
