Illegal Pits in Northwestern New Mexico Schlosser Federal WN 8E, F-27-28N-11W

To Whom It May Concern:

New Mexico Oil Conservation Order R-8952 (for the protection of migratory birds) became effective June 15, 1989 and states that <u>all pits</u> and open top tanks more than 16' in diameter shall be screened, netted or covered. Field inspections on and February 11, 1993 revealed that the above mentioned pit requires compliance.

Exceptions to the order may be requested for pits which do not generally contain hydrocarbons, by filing Form C-134. No requests for exceptions have been received in this office for this pit.

You are hereby directed to submit exceptions to this office by March 15, 1993. A C-134 has been enclosed for your convenience.
