Reference is made to the following wells located in the Gallegos Canyon Unit, San Juan County, New Mexico:

1. No. 158, 1545' FNL & 1090' FWL, Sec. 36, T. 28 N., R. 13 W., Lease NMSF-077967; *Pressure Test Casing*
2. No. 201E, 900' ESL & 1850' FEL, Sec. 11, T. 28 N., R. 12 W., Lease NMSF-078828A; and *Pressure Test Casing*
3. No. 153, 1065' FNL & 1710' FEL Sec. 28, T. 29 N., R. 12 W., Lease NMM-03526.

The subject wells have been approved for temporarily abandonment until April 1, 1995 to allow additional time to evaluate up-hole potential (see your December 12, 1994 Sundry Notices). Since the wells are to remain temporarily abandoned, you are required to test the casing integrity. This office must be notified 48 hours prior to the tests so they may be witnessed.

You have 30 days to comply with this order. The 30 days commence upon receipt of this letter or seven days from the date it is mailed, whichever is less. Failure to comply within the 30 days will result in strict enforcement of 43 CFR 3163.1.

Under provisions of 43 CFR 3165.3, you may request an Administrative Review of the orders described above. Such requests, including all supporting documents, must be filed in writing within 20-business days of receipt of this notice and must be filed with the State Director, Bureau of Land Management, P. O. Box 27115, Santa Fe, New Mexico 87504-0115. Such requests shall not result in a suspension of the orders unless the reviewing official so determines. Procedures governing appeals from instructions, orders or decisions are contained in 43 CFR 3165.4 and 43 CFR 4.400 *et seq.*
