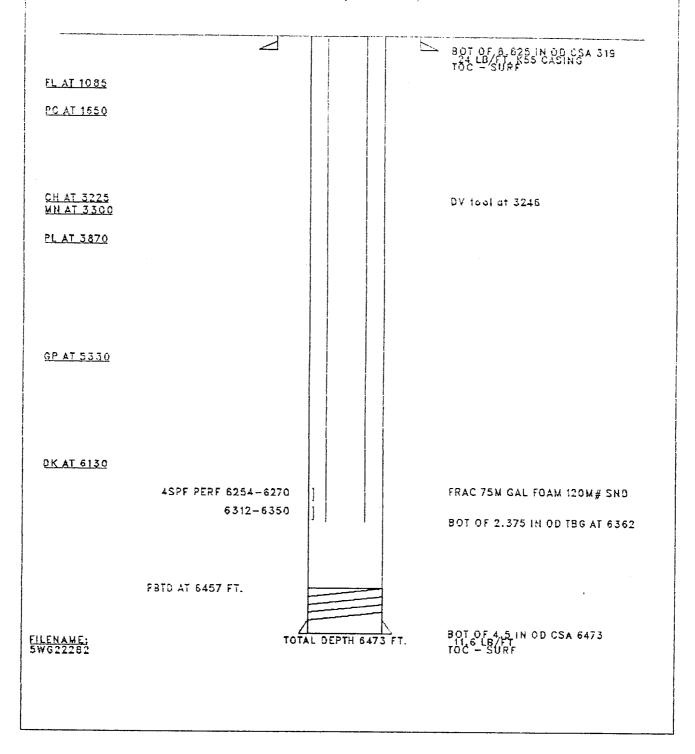

- 1. MIRUSU. NDWH. NUBOPE.
- 3. Load hole with 9 ppg mud. POOH w/ 2 3/8" tubing.
- 4. RIH w/ tubing and cement retainer. Set retainer at 6200'.
- 5. Squeeze perforations w/ 45 cu. ft. cement.
- 6. Pull out of retainer and spot 130 cu. ft. cement on top of retainer.
- 7. POOH, laying down tubing, spotting a cement plug from 4000' to 3100' (118 cu. ft.).
- 8. Pressure test cement integrity.
- 9. Spot a cement plug from 1750 to surface (230 cu. ft.).
- 10. NDBOPE. Cut off casing and wellhead. Install PxA marker according to BLM and State requirements.
- 11. Turn well over to John Jenson for reclamation.
- 12. Rehabilitate location according to BLM and State requirements.
