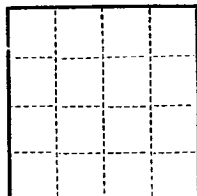

DETAILS OF WORK

Proposed: Drill to 175', set and cement 2-5/8" CB casing w/ 150 lb 45 gal cement. Drill to 307'. Set 2-1/2" CB casing and cement w/ 200 lb 45 gal cement. Following the setting of 2-1/2" CB casing, drill well to an approximate total depth of 4252'. Gas sands are expected @ 3937 - 4000 and 4100 - 4250 sand from both zones, upper and true Pictured Cliff, simultaneously down casing using 20,000 gals. w/ 1/2 sand per gal. Test, clean out, run tubing and complete.

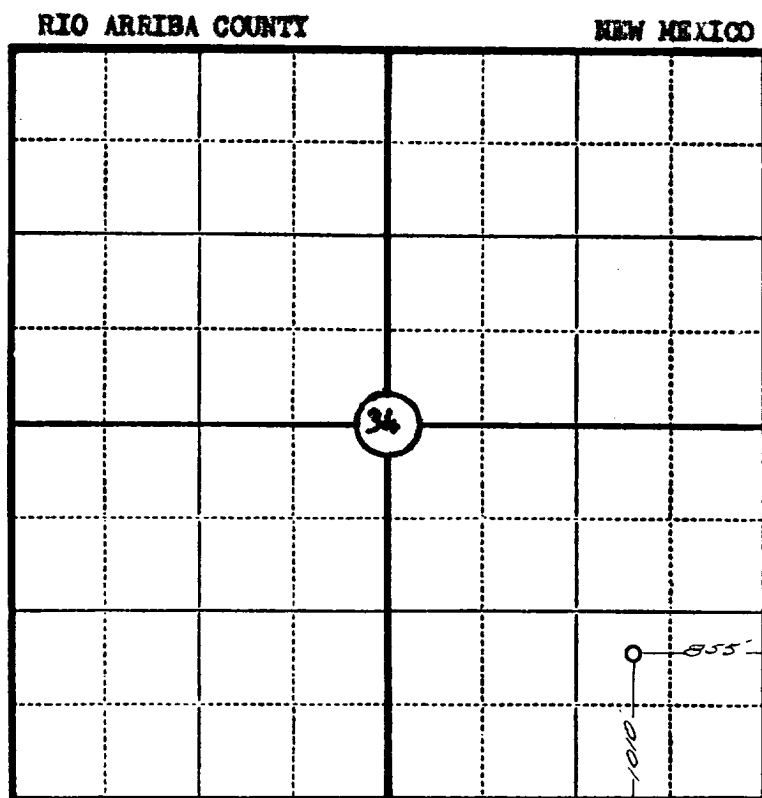
