The subject well was completed as a MV well in Sept. 1956. Plans are now to stimulate the Pt. Lookout and Menefee intervals within the MV formation. Add Lewis Shale pay and stimulate and then add pay to the Picture Cliffs formation and stimulate. Once the new PC pay interval stabilizes, PPCo plans on commingling production per DHC Order No. R-11187. The individual well commingling application will be filed and approval received before actual commingling occurs. Brief details we will use are as follows:

MIRU. COOH w/tubing. Cleanout to PBTB. If records or logs indicate no cement across the zones of interest, it may be necessary to shoot squeeze holes in casing and pump sufficient volumes of cement to cover and isolate these intervals. Set CIPB @ 4850' above highest perfs and add Lewis Shale pay and stimulate. Then shut-in well & isolate existing perfs. Ensure adequate cement coverage across the Pictured Cliffs. Perforate the Pictured Cliffs per Reservoir Engr instructions. Acidize perfs w/750 gal 15% HCL & ballsealers. Knock balls off. Stimulate the PC w/70 Quality N2 foam and sand. Flow back on 1/4" and 1/2" chokes until cleaned-up. Cleanout bridge plug above Lewis Shale. Land tubing and place well on Pictured Cliffs production only for approximately 6 months until pressures stabilize.

Once pressures from the Pictured Cliffs is below initial Mesaverde pressure, RIH & drillout remaining CIBPs and cleanout to PBTB. Rerun tubing and then commingle production from both zones.



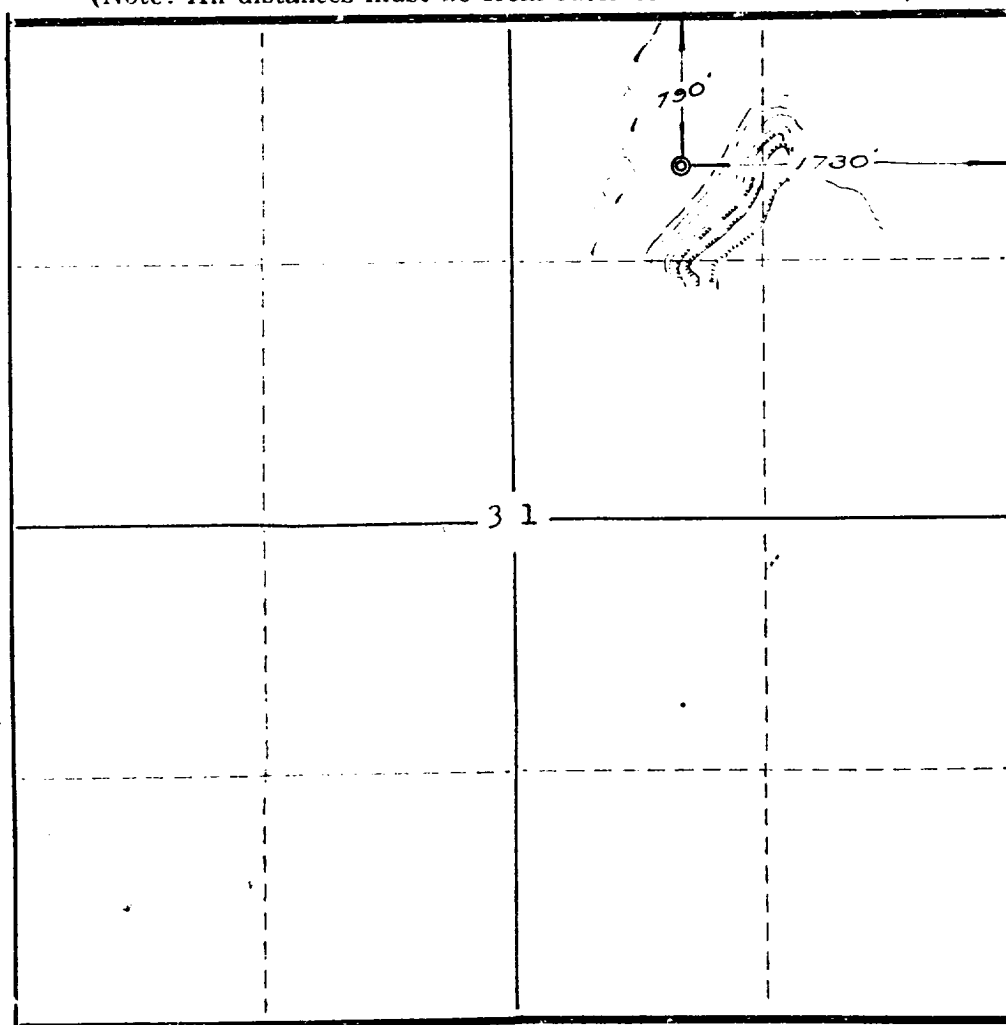
