Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of a non-standard well location for your San Juan Unit Well No. 34-34, to be located 1425 feet from the North line and 2080 feet from the East line and in the SW/4 NE/4 of Section 34, Township 29 North, Range 5 West, Blanco Mesaverde Gas Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that the request for such exception is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section.

Inasmuch as you are the only offset operator, it is possible for immediate approval to be granted. Therefore, by authority granted me under provisions of Rule 1, Section (c) of the Special Rules and Regulations of the Blanco-Mesaverde Gas Pool, as set forth in Order R-110, as amended by Order R-397, paragraph (4), you are hereby granted an exception to Order R-110, Section (c), for the above described unorthodox well location. You must also obtain like permission from the U. S. Geological Survey.
