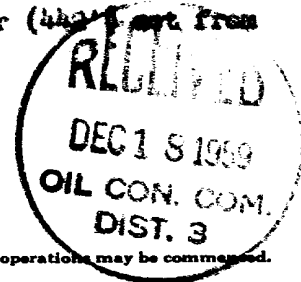

On 11-17-59 T.D. 6214'. Ran 13 joints 5", J-55, 15.00% liner (442' set from 7757' to 6199' with 75 sacks Pozmix S-140.
Held 1000%/30 minutes.
Top of cement by temperature survey at 7757'.
