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NORTHWEST NEW MEXICO PACKER LEAKAGE TEST INSTRUCTIONS

1. A packer leakage sent shall be commenced on each multiply completed will within seven days after actual completion of the well, and annually thereafter as prescribed by the order authorizing the multiple completion. Such sents shall be commenced or all multiple completions within seven days following recompletions and/or chemical or fracture treatment, and whenever remedial work has been done on a well during which the packer or the subing have been disturbed. Tests shall also be taken at any time that communication is suspected or when requested by the Division.

- At least 72 hours prior to the commencement of any packer test, the operator shall notify the Division in writing of he exact time the test is to be commenced. Offset operators shall also be notified.
- Parker leakage near shall commence when both zones of the dual completion are shut-in for pressure ambifusation. Both
 zones shall remain shut-in until the well-head pressure in each has stabilized, provided however, that they need not remain shutin more than seven days.
- 4. For Flow Test No. 1, one zone of the dual completion shall be produced at the normal rase of production while the other zone remains shurin. Such sex shall be continued for seven days in the case of a gas well and for 24 hours in the case of an oil well. Note: if, on an initial packer leakage sex, a gas well in being flowed to the atmosphere due to the lack of a pipeline connection the flow period shall be three hours.
- 5. Following completion of flow Test No. 1, the well shall again be shur-in, in accordance with Paragraph 3 shows

- 6. Flow Test No. 2 shall be conducted even though no leak was indicated during Flow Test No. 1. Procedure for Flow Test No. 2 is to be the same as for Flow Test No. 1 except that the previously produced zone shall remain shur-in while the zone which was previously shur-in produced.
- 7. Pressure for gar-sone tests must be measured on each zone with a dead-weight pressure gauge at time intervals as follows: 3 hours test: immediately prior to the beginning of each flow-period, at fifteen minute intervals during the first hour thereof, and at hourly intervals thereafter, including one pressure measurement immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. A dead we take the monodisted prior to the beginning of each flow period, at least one time during each flow period gas prominently the midway point) and immediately prior to the conclusion of each flow period. Other pressures may be taken as desired, or may be requested on wells which have previously shown questionable test dist.

 24-hour oil sone tests all pressures, throughout the entire test, shall be continuously measured and recorded with recording pressure gauge the accuracy of which must be checked at least rwice, once at the beginning and once at the end of each test, with a deadweight pressure gauge. If a well is gas-oil or a oil-gas that completion, the recording gauge shall be required on the oil sone early, with deadweight pressures as equired above being taken on the gas zone.
- 8. The rendez of the above described texts shall be filed in triplicate within 15 days after the completion of the text. Texts shall be filed with the Assec District Office of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Division on Northwest New Mexico Packer Leslage Text Form Revised 1001/37 with all deadweight pressure indicated thereon as well as the flowing tamperstures (gas nones only) and gravity and GOR (oil nones only).
