ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER  
OF THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Under the provisions of Rule 112-A (c) Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation made application to the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on August 10, 1959, for permission to dually complete its San Juan 29-6 Unit Well No. 47-28 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota formation.

Now, on this 31st day of August, 1959, the Secretary-Director finds:

- (1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of Sub-section 'c' of Rule 112-A of the Commission's Rules and Regulations;
- (2) That satisfactory information has been provided that all operators of offset acreage have been duly notified; and
- (3) That no objections have been received within the waiting period as prescribed by said rule.
- (4) That the proposed dual completion will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.
- (5) That the mechanics of the proposed dual completion are feasible and consonant with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant herein, Pacific Northwest Pipeline Corporation, be and the same is hereby authorized to dually complete its San Juan 29-6 Unit Well No. 47-28 located in the NW/4 NE/4 of Section 28, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool and the production of gas from an undesignated Dakota formation through parallel strings of tubing.

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That applicant shall complete, operate, and produce said well in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 112-A.

Commission made application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission  
on August 10, 1953, for permission of unit San Juan 58-6 Unit  
Mile No. 45-58 located in the NW 1/4 of Section 58, Township 58 North,  
Range 6 West, NMW, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as  
to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Measerde Pool and the produc-  
tion of gas from an undesigned Dakota formation.

Now, on this thirty-first day of August, 1953, the Secretary-Director finds:

(1) That application has been duly filed under the provisions of sub-  
section 'c' of Rule 115-A of the Conservation Rules and Regulations;  
(2) That application has been provided for all objectives  
and constitutes a good conservation plan; and  
(3) That no objection has been received within the mailing period  
described by said rule.

That the proposed draft completion will not cause waste nor interfere  
with the public interest.

(4) That the description of the proposed unit completion is less than  
and consisting with good conservation practices.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the applicant, Public Utilities Commission, be and the same is hereby authorized to draft completion of unit San Juan 58-6 Unit  
Mile No. 45-58 located in the NW 1/4 of Section 58, Township 58 North,  
Range 6 West, NMW, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, in such a manner as  
to permit the production of gas from the Blanco-Measerde Pool and the produc-  
tion of gas from an undesigned Dakota formation during

PROVIDED HOWEVER, That application shall continue, effective, and  
proceed as set forth in accordance with the provisions of Section V, Rule 115-A.

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PROVIDED FURTHER, That applicant shall take packer-leakage tests upon completion and annually thereafter during the Annual deliverability Test Period for the Dakota zone.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED: That jurisdiction of this cause is hereby retained by the Commission for such further order or orders as may seem necessary or convenient for the prevention of waste and/or protection of correlative rights; upon failure of applicant to comply with any requirement of this order, after proper notice and hearing the Commission may terminate the authority hereby granted and require applicant or its successors and assigns to limit its activities to regular single-zone production in the interests of conservation.
