Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your application for approval of an unorthodox well location for your San Juan Unit Well No. 64-9 to be located 1450 feet from the North line and 2250 feet from the East line of Section 9, Township 29 North, Range 6 West, Blanco-Mesaverde Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

It is our understanding that this unorthodox well location is based upon extreme topographic conditions in the NE/4 of said section 9.
