We recently approved a Form C-110 submitted by Tennessee Gas Transmission Co on the #1 Manning-State in the SW $\frac{1}{4}$ Section 2-29N-7W. This form stated that they were taking over the operation of this well. At the same time Tennessee Gas Transmission Co. did take over operation of all wells operated by Bay Petroleum Co. in the San Juan Basin; however the #1 Manning-State is within an El Paso unit and is therefore operated by El Paso Natural Gas Co. The Form C-110 was filed in error and should be disregarded. El Paso should remain as operator.

We are giving this letter the same distribution as Form C-110 and hope that it will enable everyond to straighten out their records.
