This well was plugged and abandoned in the following manner:

1. Mixed 200 sack cement plug, followed by top rubber plug. Displaced w/200 barrels of water, pressure to 2000#. Top of cement plug @ 5100'.
2. Backed off 7" casing at 250'. Spotted 45 sacks of cement on 7" stub.
3. Pulled 7" casing.
4. Spotted 20 sack cement plug in surface casing and erected 4' x 4" dry hole marker.

Investment and other studies will not be completed until writing by the Geological Service before operations may be commenced.
