Run 7" casing top to bottom as follows: 2 Jts. 7" OD 2 3/4 J-55 @ 81.28', 95 Jts. 7" OD 2 3/4 J-55 @ 3950.80', 28 Jts. 7" OD 2 3/4 J-55 @ 1145.88'. Total 7" casing 5177.64'. Casing set at 5182'. Cemented with 300 sack reg. cement. used plug to 5145'. Job completed 10:30 pm, 11-24-52. November 28, 1952 thru December 6, 1952 FOC, displacing mud with gas and trouble with frozen gas. Tested casing with 300# for 15 min., tested OK. Drilled cement plug at 7:00 am, 12-6-52. Tested hole with 300# for 15 min., tested OK.
